ORAL ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Ms.P.J. Davawala for the applicant and learned advocate Mr.P.S. Brahmabhatt for learned advocate Mr.R.D. Patadia for the respondent.

2. Learned advocate Ms.P.J. Davawala for the applicant-Official Liquidator has tendered compliance report pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 16.02.2022 and 11.03.2022. The same is ordered to be taken on record.

3. Learned advocate Ms.P.J. Davawala prays for further time to place on record the re-verification report from the Chartered Accountant with regard to 24 employees, who has submitted

the detailed report out of 27 employees pursuant to the letter dated 28th February, 2022 issued by the Official Liquidator.

4. It was also pointed out that out of 586 employees/workers, the Official Liquidator received bank details from 327 workers and till the date of the compliance report 319 workers' payments were made through RTGS/NEFT and 8 workers could not be paid due to incomplete bank details.

5. Learned advocate Ms.P.J. Davawala further pointed out that the details of 259 workers are yet to be received. As as and when, such details would be received, the Official Liquidator to do the needful for payment of the claim for the workers as per the report of the chartered accountant as per the earlier orders.
