ORAL ORDER
(PER : HONOURABLE MS. JUSTICE SANGEETA K. VISHEN)

Mr.Parth Thummar, learned Advocate appearing for the respondent-wife submitted that this Court, vide order dated 03.10.2024 requested the Family Court, Godhra to appoint a conciliator of a relatively senior standing so that he/she can interact with the children. Accordingly, the conciliator was appointed and had furnished a report; contents whereof are recorded in the order dated 07.01.2025. This Court, therefore, accepting the submissions of both the parties, allowed the respondent-wife to interact with the children through telephonic calls/video calls for twice a week.

2. Mr.Thummar, learned Advocate submitted that the parties have internally agreed that the respondent-wife shall make the calls on Thursday and Sunday between 7:00 p.m.

and 8:00 p.m. It is submitted that at times, the respondent-wife is facing difficulty in approaching the children owing to one or another reason.

3. It will be open for the respective parties not to restrict the telephonic calls/video calls to Thursday and Sunday. If the respondent-wife is unable to approach the children or misses the call on Thursday, it will be open for the respondent-wife to call the children on the next day or the day thereafter between 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Similar arrangement shall continue for Sunday as well.

4. List the matter on 11.02.2026. Let the appellant along with the children and the respondent remain present on that day.
