1. Mr Vaibhav N. Sheth, learned advocate for the appellant submitted that the application was filed seeking divorce by the respondent which has been granted mainly on two grounds, namely, cruelty and desertion. It is submitted that the learned Judge, was of the opinion that non-mentioning or denial of the parental identity, would amount to cruelty as, it is a significant life events of the child and serious infringement of the father's emotional, social involvement. It is submitted that in paragraph 9.3 of the cross-examination, the appellant-wife though has stated that in view of the consent divorce, she has demanded Rs.33 lacs; however, she has admitted that she is ready to resume matrimonial life with the respondent-husband. The aspect of transferring the residential house in the name of the daughters, was only with a view to take care of the future of the daughters.
