ORAL ORDER

1. Heard Mr. Shegun B. Chokshi, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioners.

2. By way of present application, the applicant herein prayed for a direction to the respondent No.2 – Mamlatdar not to pass final order or otherwise in IRCMS Case No.84(C)/VDD/27/2025 (erroneously referred to as Ganot Case No.29/2025 in the notice) pending the final disposal of the present petition wherein by order dated 24.11.2025, the show-cause notice dated 19.09.2025 issued by the Mamlatdar and ALT, wherein the said notice is issued for violation of Section 63 and is

initiating proceedings under Section 84C of the Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act stands stayed by way of ad interim relief in terms of prayer para 21(B) till the next returnable date.

3. Upon perusal of the record, it emerges that the interim order is extended from time to time. Upon perusal of the rojkaam produced on record, it prima facie cannot be disputed that though the show cause notice itself is stayed by the interim order dated 24.11.2025, the learned Mamlatdar and ALT appeared to have proceeded with the hearing of the IRCMS Case No.84(C)/VDD/27/2025.

4. In the interest of justice, the final order is directed not to be passed pending the present petition. Interim relief in terms of para 21(B) stands confirmed till final disposal of the petition.
