The petitioner has preferred present petition under Articles 14, 19, 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India r/w the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice, it is desirable to send the matter before the Gujarat High Court Mediation Centre. Even, learned advocates appearing for both the sides have also agreed to send the matter before the Gujarat High Court Mediation Centre.

In view of the above, the Registry is hereby directed to place this matter before the Gujarat High Court Mediation Centre. The Secretary, Gujarat High Court

Legal Services Committee, shall appoint a senior and experienced Mediator to facilitate resolution of the dispute. The learned Mediator shall conduct the mediation proceedings and submit a report on or before the next date of hearing.

Learned advocates for both sides shall furnish the relevant particulars of their clients, including contact numbers, to the learned Mediator to enable issuance of notice for their appearance on the date fixed for mediation. In case of any difficulty, the learned advocates are at liberty to remain present before the learned Mediator and assist in amicable resolution of the dispute.

In the event the mediation fails, the matter shall be proceeded with on its own merits.
