1. Heard Mr. Arsh H. Joshi, learned advocate appearing for the applicants. Perused the entire materials on record along with the FIR.

2. It appears that the complainant and the applicants-accused are the relatives and the alleged incident had occurred on a trivial issue. It is alleged that the accused No. 4 - Dashrathbhai Vardhichand Prajapati had inflicted stick blows on the left hand of the wife of the complainant, however, it appears from the endorsement made on the police Yadi dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure 'D') that she has not taken any treatment from any hospital. The Court has also considered the history given by the complainant to the Doctor, wherein he has specifically mentioned that they were assaulted with fisticuffs. It also appears from the FIR that since the matter has

not been settled between the parties, the impugned complaint has been filed.

3. In view of the aforesaid, issue **Notice** to the respondents, making it returnable on **17.03.2026**.

4. Learned APP Mr. Manan Maheta waives service of notice for and on behalf of respondent No.1 - State. The respondent no.2 shall be served directly through the Investigating Officer of the concerned Police Station.

5. In the meantime, let there be an ad-interim relief in terms of paragraph 11(C) qua the present applicants, till the next date of hearing.
