1. We have heard learned counsel Mr. Aaditya Bhatt with Ms. Chandni Joshi, Mr. Ankit Shah with Mr. Sundeep Sadawarte and Mr. Arun Dev and Ms. Zeel Raval and Mr. L.B. Dabhi appearing for the respective parties.

2. After hearing some time, Mr. Bhatt, learned counsel, upon instructions, does not press this appeal and seeks permission to file fresh application for bail before the trial court as and when there would be a change in fact situation.
