ORAL ORDER

(PER : HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE A.Y. KOGJE)

1. In continuation of our earlier order dated 16.06.2025 and 14.07.2025, the child is brought before the Court and the Court has briefly interacted with the child and thereafter, have independently interacted with the appellant-husband and respondent-wife.

2. Considering the overall fact situation, the Court is of the view that the existing situation is acting against the interest of the child, who even according to learned advocate for the appellant, has faced some psychological disorder and in that connection, learned advocate has given for perusal the medical certificate.

3. In the aforesaid set of facts, the Court deems it fit to direct the appellant to consult psychologist/psychiatrist, who will conduct joint and independent sessions for both, the appellant-husband and respondent-wife and if need be, may also arrange necessary sessions for the son. The appellant shall bear the cost of consultation and report in this regard be placed before the Court on 18.08.2025. The psychologist/psychiatrist will be identified by the appellant himself and maximum of eight sittings to be conducted. S.O. to **18.08.2025**.
