1. Heard Mr. Tattvam K. Patel, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Hardik Soni, learned advocate appearing for the respondent authorities.

2. By way of the present petition, the petitioner herein is constrained to challenge the issuance of the impugned notice by the Mamlatdar and ALT, Gandhinagar, being No. Mamlatdar/Ganot/Vashi/1205/2025, dated 06.11.2025.

3. Mr. Patel, learned advocate submitted that the petitioner is an agriculturalist by birth. The petitioner's father is also an agriculturalist and holding various parcels of agricultural lands and out of such, the land held by the petitioner was subject matter of proceedings under Section 84C of the Bombay Tenancy and

Agricultural Lands Act, 1948 (for short, “the Act”), which attained finality wherein, the notice under Section 84C of the Tenancy Act stood dropped. The orders were confirmed by the Deputy Collector on 23.12.1997. It is submitted that the impugned notice issued by the respondent authority recites same the parcel of land. It is submitted that the said notice is issued upon the complaint at the behest of a third person. It is further submitted that such proceedings at the instance of a third person, even otherwise are without jurisdiction. The respondent authority has exceeded in its jurisdiction by issuing such notice dated 06.11.2025.

3. Submissions made by Mr. Patel, learned advocate, prima-facie, require consideration.
4. Issue notice making it returnable on 20.01.2026. Mr. Hardik Soni, learned AGP waives service of notice for and on behalf of respondent no. 1.
5. Direct service qua respondent no. 3 is permitted.
6. In the interregnum period, let there be interim relief in terms of paragraph no. 18(C).
7. To be tagged with Special Civil Application No. 11972 of 2025.
