ORAL ORDER

1. Learned advocate Ms. R.Z. Sindhi appearing for the applicants does not press the present Criminal Misc. Application qua the applicant No.1 - Jiteshbhai Madhusudanbhai Gaikwad. Hence, the present Criminal Misc. Application stands disposed of qua the applicant No.1 - Jiteshbhai Madhusudanbhai Gaikwad as not pressed.

2. Heard learned advocate Ms. R.Z. Sindhi, learned advocate appearing for the applicants Nos. 2 to 4. Perused the entire materials on record along with the FIR.

3. It appears that the applicants Nos.2, 3 and 4 are the mother-in-law and sisters-in-law respectively of the complainant and the allegations levelled qua them in the F.I.R. are vague,

omnibus and general in nature. In view of the aforesaid, in the considered opinion of this Court, the present application deserves consideration qua the applicants Nos. 2 to 4.

4. Hence, **RULE** returnable on **17.03.2026**.

5. Learned APP Mr. Manan Maheta waives service of notice of Rule for and on behalf of respondent No.1 - State. The respondent no.2 shall be served directly through the Investigating Officer of the concerned Police Station.

6. In the meantime, let there be an ad-interim relief in terms of paragraph No. 7-B, qua the applicants Nos. 2 to 4, till the next date of hearing.
