Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents in not paying the pension as per last pay drawn even after Hon'ble High Court passed orders to pay arrears in WP No.34841/2023 as being illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and is contrary to Rule 33 of Pension Rules and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to pay full pension;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to pay the pension considering the last drawn pay, pending disposal of WP 1604 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, there shall be an interim direction to the respondents to pay the Pension to the petitioner, basing on his last drawn pay.
