WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri Praveen Kumar Challa, presented this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents in not paying the pension as per last pay drawn even after Hon'ble High Court passed orders to pay arrears in WP No.33790/2013 as being illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and is contrary to Rule 33 of Pension Rules and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to pay full pension;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed therein, and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Praveen Kumar Challa, Advocate for the Petitioner, and the GP for Services-I, for the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 20-02-2024 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2024:

Petition under Section 151 of CPC, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to pay the pension considering the last drawn pay, pending disposal of WP No. 1676 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Learned Government Pleader for Services-I takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and waives further notice and seeks time to file counter affidavit.

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 in view of this waiver.

Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, there shall be an interim direction to the respondents to pay the Pension to the petitioner, basing on his last drawn pay.
