Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No. 2 and 3 in not correcting the revenue illegal entries, and not cancelling the Pattadar Pass Book-cum-Title Deeds by considering our application no. 2300157853 and 2300157854, dated 25.10.2023, which have been issued illegally to the Respondents No. 4 to 10 in respect of Sy. No. 576/2 an extent of Ac. 01.17½ Gts, each to the respondent No.5 and 6 total extent of Ac. 02.35 gts was illegally transferred in the name of respondent No.5 and 6, land in Sy.No. 580 an extent of Ac. 02.13 was mutated in the name of respondent no.4-10, the respondent No.5 land in Sy No.580/EE an extent of Ac. 0.2300 gts, land in Sy No.580/1 an extent of Ac. 0.0350 gts, respondent no.6 land in Sy No.580/a, an extent of Ac. 0.1100 gts, land in SyNo.580/5, an extent of Ac. 0.0.200 gts , respondent no.7 land in Sy No.580/b an extent of Ac. 0.1100 gts, respondent no.8 land in Sy No.580/AA an extent of Ac. 0.2300 gts, respondent no.9 land in Sy No.580/2 an extent of Ac. 0.1100 gts, the respondent no.10 who is the wife of petitioner No.2 was recorded land in Sy No.580/4 an extent of Ac. 0.0.200 gts and also petitioner No.2 wife Namely late Bokka Laxmi was also recorded in Sy No.580/4, an extent of Ac. 0.0.200 gts the respondent officials did not follow the due procedure, and in my absence the respondents played fraud to get their names entered into the revenue records in respect of the agriculture land, situated at Nandiwada village Shivar of Tadwai Mandal, Kamareddy District is highly arbitrary and illegal violation of Article 19,21 and 300-A of the constitution of India and against the principles of natural justice.

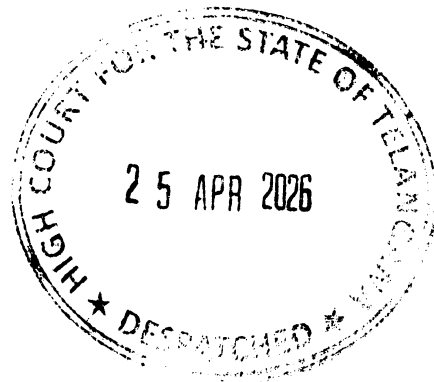
