Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or orders or Writ or more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the challenging the inaction of the Respondents No. 2 to 4 herein in respect of unauthorized/illegal construction of Shed and Board in petitioners land situated at Sy.No.93/A of Mailardevpally, Rajendranagar, R.R. District despite the petitioners representations/complaint dated 23.11.2019 and 5.12.2019 as arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the provisions of Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Act, 1955 and as well as the direction given by this Honble Court in W.P.Nos.19731 and 19667 of 2019 besides being violative of Article 14 and 21 of the constitution of India;

Even after six years, no such report has been filed by respondent No.3/GHMC.

At request of learned Standing counsel for GHMC, post on 15.06.2026, for action taken report pursuant to order dated 19.02.2020, failing which, respondent No.3 shall appear in person.
