Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order, direction, writ, more particularly Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 in allotting the Petitioners to Zone-II and III in pursuant to the Telangana Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulations of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2018 in violation of the guidelines contained in G.O.Ms.No.317 General Administration (SPF-1) Department, dated 06.12.2021 and the Judgment in W.P.No.31434 of 2023, dated 02.12.2024 as illegal, improper, unjust, arbitrary, contrary to law and violative of Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and further direct the Respondent No.2 to allot the Petitioners to Zone-V, VI, VII (Multi-Zone-II) as per their options in terms of the order dated 02.12.2024 in W.P.No.31434 of 2023.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the representations of the Petitioners dated 22.10.2025 respectively in terms of Order dated 02.12.2024 in W.P.No.31434 of 2023 and G.O.Ms.No.317 General Administration (SPF-1) Department, dated 06.12.2021 forthwith, pending disposal of WP 2765 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
