WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate DR. KADIRI KRISHNAIAH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the inaction of the respondents in not sanctioning the pensionary benefits as well as benefits of retirement even after retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 03/04/2010 basing on pending disciplinary case against the husband of the petitioner in guise of suspension on the false grounds wherein the petitioner's husband was falsely implicated vide Proceedings No.1219/137/VO/2009, Dt. 02/09/2009, issued by the Vice-Chairman and Housing Commissioner on the file of vigilance case as illegal, contrary to law, unjust, unconstitutional, discriminatory and against to the principles of the natural justice and consequently set aside the suspension proceedings No.1219/137/VO/2009, Dt. 02/09/2009 issued by the Vice-chairman and Housing Commissioner as per the Judgment of Y.Anjaneyulu and The State of Andhra Pradesh Rep.by its secretary Home (Printing) Dept. Hyderabad, Dt. 21/07/1998 (A.P. Administrative Tribunal Hyderabad) and G.O.M.S. No.275, FIN and PLG, Dt. 08/08/1977 and F.R. (Fundamental Rules of Employees) 54(B)(2) by directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits along with retirement benefits to the legal heirs such as the petitioner (wife) in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri DR. KADIRI KRISHNAIAH, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri A.K. Jayaprakash Rao, Standing Counsel for Housing for respondent Nos. 1 & 2, Government Pleader for Services-III for respondent No.3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
