Ms. Swapna Madhuri, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department appears for respondent Nos.2 to 4. Mr. Sahas Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appears for respondent No.5. The instant PIL is being instituted on a Letter Petition taking note of the news article published in Eenadu Telugu Daily Newspaper dated 31.10.2025 referring to an incident where one resident of Jayyaram Village, Chinnaguduru Mandal, Mahabubabad District suffering from Kidney and other ailments was refused treatment at a Civil Hospital, Mahabubabad District on the ground that he was not accompanied by any attendant and not possessing Aadhaar Card. He remained unconscious near the Hospital Canteen area for three days and presuming him to be dead, he was shifted to Mortuary on the next day. However, the sweeping staff noticed signs of movement and alerted the police. Thereafter, the Town Police intervened and shifted him for medical treatment. This state of affair depicts the serious lacunae in providing Medicare facilities to the residents of the State which is treated to be one of the facets of Article 21 of the Constitution of India i.e., right to life.	

Learned Government Pleader for General Administration Department appearing for respondent No.1-State seeks time to file a counter affidavit indicating the comprehensive policy decision and guidelines issued as regards provision of Medicare facilities and specially to persons who are suffering from serious diseases.

Three weeks' time, as prayed for, is allowed.
