	30.06.2026	<u>JAK, J</u> This Writ Petition is filed with the following prayer: “...to issue a Writ of certiorari or any other Writ are order of a like nature calling for the records pertaining to G.O.Ms.No.786, Revenue (SS-I) Department, dated 5-9-1991 and quash the same. Further costs be awarded....” There is no representation on behalf of petitioners. Two WPMPS’ are listed along with writ petition i.e., I.A.No.1 of 2002 (WPMP No.16227 of 2002) and I.A.No.2 of 2002 (WPMP No.27486 of 2002) in the cause list toady. In the proceeding sheet it is reflected that WPMP No.16227 of 2002 along with WPMP No.875 of 1996 were taken up and the following order is passed on 25.09.2002. “The writ petitioners filed the application in W.P.M.P.No.875 of 1996 to implead Mr.V.R.Jagathaiah and Mr.M.V.Suryanarayana Raju as party respondent Nos.3 and 4 in the writ petition. In fact, it is urged that the order of the State Government in G.O.Ms.No.786, Revenue (SS-I) Department dated:05.05.1991 (the impugned order in the writ petition) was issued by the Government at their instance. While disposing of the writ petition, this application-WPMP No.875 of 1996 was not noticed and no orders were passed thereon. In the circumstances as they would be prejudiced, they filed an application in WPMP No.16227 of 2002 by way of an application “for being mentioned”, seeking that WPMP No.875/1996 filed for impleading them as party respondents be ordered. It is noticed that by inadvertence and oversight, no orders have been passed in WPMP No.875 of 1996. It is also noticed that the proposed respondents in WPMP No.875 of 1996 are interested in the out come of the writ petition and would be vitally affected by the	Transferred to IO folder, before corrections, if any.
