WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI SARATH KUMAR D presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the respondents No.1 to 3 in not responding on the Representation dt.03.01.2026 submitted by the petitioner for initiating necessary legal action against the respondents 4 to 7 who acted

negligently and irresponsibly while conducting a Slip Test on a Public Holiday on 26.12.2025, by mounting hectic pressure and causing untimely and unnatural death of petitioners only son and for payment of compensation and other damages for the loss of life of petitioners son due to utter negligence and mismanagement on the part of respondents 4 to 7, as illegal, irregular, arbitrary, violative of principles of natural justice, violative of Doctrine of Legitimate Expectation and offends Article 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents 4 to 7 to pay compensation and other damages for the loss of life of petitioners son due to utter negligence and mismanagement on the part of respondents 4 to 7.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SARATH KUMAR D Advocate for the Petitioner, Ms.Sujatha Kurrapati, Assistant Government Pleader for Higher Education for the respondent Nos.1 and 2, Mr.Raj Kumar Rudra, standing counsel for respondent No.3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 4 to 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 11.03.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to consider and respond on petitioners Representation dated 03.01.2026, submitted for initiating necessary legal action against the respondents 4 to 7, pending disposal of WP No. 4071 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No.4 to 7 to pay compensation and other damages to the petitioners family for the loss of life of petitioners son due to utter negligence and

mismanagement on the part of respondents 4 to 7, pending disposal of WP No. 4071 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Notice before admission.

Ms.Sujatha Kurrapati, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Higher Education takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and waives further notice.

Mr.Raj Kumar Rudra, learned standing counsel for respondent No.3 is present.

Issue notice on respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Personal notice is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, due to negligence on the part of respondent Nos.4 to 7, the minor son of the petitioner had died on 26.12.2025. In that connection, the petitioner has filed a detailed representation dated 03.01.2026 before respondent No.3 through registered post. But so far, no action has been taken by respondent No.3 on the said representation.

In that view of the matter, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 03.01.2026 submitted by the petitioner and file a detailed report by the next date of hearing.
