Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 to 5 in interfering with the peaceful possession of the petitioners' respective agricultural lands in Sy.No.285/7 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas, in Sy.No.285/27 to an extent of Ac.0.2200guntas. in Sy.No.285/28 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas and Sy.No.285/29 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 gts (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.000 gts). and in Sy.No.285/ 16 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas Sy.No.285/25 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.3200 gts) situated at Ayyagaripalli Village of Kuravi Mandal Mahabubabad District, in the name of construction of government school without issuance of acquisition proceedings as per Act 30 of 2013, is illegal, arbitrary and against the provisions of Act 30 of 2013 and also violates the principles of natural justice and against the constitutional principles laid down in Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents No.2 to 5 not to interfere and not to dispossess with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners respective agricultural lands in Sy.No.285/7 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas, in Sy.No.285/27 to an extent of Ac.0.2200 guntas. in Sy.No.285/28 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas and Sy.No.285/29 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 gts (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.000

gts). and in Sy.No.285/16 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas 86 Sy.No.285/25 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.3200 gts) situated at Ayyagaripalli Village of Kuravi Mandal, Mahabubabad District.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents No.2 to 5 not to interfere and not to dispossess with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners' respective agricultural lands in Sy.No.285/7 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas, in Sy.No.285/27 to an extent of Ac.0.2200 guntas. in Sy.No.285/28 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 guntas & Sy.No.285/29 to an extent of Ac.0.2000 gts (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.000 gts). and in Sy.No.285/ 16 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas 86 Sy.No.285/25 to an extent of Ac.0.1600 guntas (total admeasuring extent Ac.1.3200 gts) situated at Ayyagaripalli Village of Kuravi Mandal, Mahabubabad District. pending disposal of the above writ petition, pending disposal of WP 4022 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI RAMAVARAM CHANDRASHEKAR REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents No. 1 to 3 and GP FOR EDUCATION for the Respondents No. 4 and 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

The petitioners claim to be the owners and possessors of the land admeasuring an extent of Ac.0-2000 guntas in Survey No.285/7, Ac.0-2200 guntas in Survey No.285/27, Ac.0-2000 guntas in Survey No.258/28 and Ac.0-2000 guntas in Survey No.285/29 (total admeasuring extent Ac.1-000 guntas); and Ac.0-1600 guntas in Survey No.285/16 & Ac.0-1600 guntas in Survey No.285/25 (total admeasuring extent Ac.1-3200 guntas), situated at Ayyagaripalli village, Kuravi Mandal, Mahabubabad District on the strength of the pattedar pass books-cum-title deeds bearing Nos. T25100050582, T25100050028, T25100050024, T25100050295.

Prima facie, the petitioners appears to be the owners of the subject property.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to respondent Nos.3 to 5 not to interfere with the possession of the petitioners in respect of the subject property without following due process of law.
