ORDER

Heard Mr. Aadesh Varma, learned counsel for the petitioner.
Perused the material on record.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner filed I.A.No.755 of 2023 in G.W.O.P.No.13 of 2023 under Section 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1980, read with Section 151 of the CPC, to grant interim custody of the minor child, Rutvik Raj Heerekar, born on 11.11.2014, be granted to the petitioner twice a week, on Saturday and Sunday, till the disposal of the main case. But the trial Court granted visitation rights of the child on every Second Saturday between 4.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M. District Legal

Services Authority, L.B. Nagar. The respondent shall take the child Rutvik Raj Heerekar to the District Legal Services Authority, L.B. Nagar on every Second Saturday between 4.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the visitation rights granted by the trial Court are insufficient to maintain a healthy relationship between the petitioner and the minor child, who is eleven (11) years old, born on 11.11.2014. It is submitted that allowing visitation only once in a month for one hour is inadequate and impractical for developing the necessary parental bond.

4. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 27.02.2026, there was no representation on behalf of the learned counsel for the respondent. Therefore, this Court directed the matter to be listed on 03.03.2026 under the caption "For Orders". Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the learned counsel for the respondent.

5. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the welfare of the minor child, this Court is of the view that the visitation schedule requires modification to better serve the interest of the child and to facilitate a healthy parent-child relationship.

6. Accordingly, the order of the trial Court in I.A.No.755 of 2023 is modified and the petitioner is permitted to visit his child on every Saturday from 3.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M. at the District Legal Services Authority, L.B. Nagar. The respondent is directed to produce the child accordingly.

7. With the above direction, the Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this Civil Revision Petition, shall stand closed.

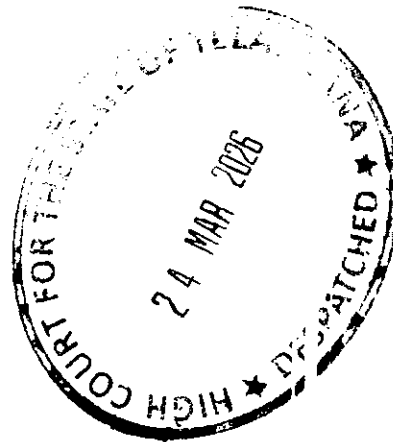
