WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI BONDEMPALLY RAMULU presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents, more particularly respondent Nos. 4 to 9, in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner's agricultural lands situated in Survey No. 119 to an extent of Ac. 3.25 guntas and Survey No. 120 to an extent of Ac. 8.33 guntas, in total Ac. 12.18 guntas, forming a single compact block situated at

Telangana State, without any authority of law and without following due process of law, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, contrary to the provisions of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said lands except by following due process of law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit and upon hearing the arguments of SRI BONDEMPALLY RAMULU Advocate for the Petitioner, AGP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents No. 1, to 5 and SRI K. PRADEEP REDDY Standing Counsel for GRAM PANCHAYAT appearing for the Respondent No.6 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.9 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 06.03.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the official respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the agricultural lands situated in Survey No. 119 to an extent of Ac. 3.25 guntas and Survey No. 120 to an extent of Ac. 8.33 guntas, in total Ac. 12.18 guntas, forming a single compact block situated at Chilemamidi Village, Ananttasagar Hamlet, Jharasangam Mandal, Sanga Reddy District, Telangana State, except by following due process of law., pending disposal of WP No.4571 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Issue notice to respondent No.9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.9 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Mr. K. Pradeep Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Gram Panchayat, appearing for respondent No.6 submits that there is no interference by respondent No.6 Gram Panchayat in the possession of the petitioner over the subject land.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent No.1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall get instructions by the next date of hearing.

On reading the contents of the affidavit, in the opinion of this Court, respondent Nos.7 and 8 are not necessary parties.

Respondent Nos.7 and 8 shall be deleted from the array of parties.

The petitioner claims to be the pattadar and possessor of the land to an extent of Acs.3-25 guntas in Survey No.119 and Acs.8-33 guntas in Survey No.120 situated at Chilemamidi Village, Anantasagar Hamlet, Jharasangam Mandal, Sanga Reddy District.

Prima facie, the petitioner is the pattadar and possessor of the subject lands.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to respondent Nos.4 to 6 not to interfere with the possession of the petitioner over the subject property without following due process of law.
