WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri M YESHWANTH KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ or orders more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents No. 2 to 4 in not taking any action against the 5th respondent and not cancelling the Pattadar pass book vide Pass Book No. T10130020297 vide Khatha No. 471 issued in respect of Agriculture land to an extent of Ac. 5-18 guntas in Sy.No. 248/2/B situated at Arjunpatla Village, Cherial Mandal, Siddipet District inspite of representation dated. 07-08-2025 made to the respondents is illegal, improper, null and void and consequently direct the respondents No. 2 to 4 to take action against the 5th respondent as per law and cancel the Pattadar pass book vide Pass Book No. T10130020297 vide Khatha No. 471, in respect of Agriculture land to an extent of Ac. 5-18 guntas in Sy.No. 248/2/B situated at Arjunpatla Village, Cherial Mandal, Siddipet District.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M YESHWANTH KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
