Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

The impugned order dated 22.08.2025, passed in M.P.No.254 of 2024 in M.C.No.421 of 2023 by the learned Judge, I Additional Family Court-cum-XIV Additional Metropolitan Sessions Court, Hyderabad, to the extent of granting interim maintenance to respondent No.2 is suspended subject to the condition that the petitioner shall pay an amount of Rs.7,500/- (Rupees Seven Thousand and Five Hundred only) per month to respondent No.2 on or before 10th of every succeeding month and shall also pay the arrears in the afore-said ratio, within a period of four (4) weeks from today. In default, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated.
