No. 353 of 2021 on the file of the Addl. Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Bhongir;

Petition Under Section 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the physical appearance of the Petitioner in C.C.No.353 of 2021 on the file of the Addl. Junior Civil Judge-Cum- Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Bhongir, Pending disposal of CRLP 2224 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Advocate Mr. E. Uma Maheswar Rao, counsel representing Mr. Enuganti Sudhanshu Rao, Advocate for the Petitioner and the ADDL. PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

When this matter is taken up for consideration, Mr. E. Uma Maheswar Rao, learned counsel representing Mr. Enuganti Sudhanshu Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that in respect of the very same proceedings in C.C.No.353 of 2021, petitioners/accused Nos.3 and 4 have approached this Court and filed CrI.P.No.4177 of 2023, and this Court while ordering notice before admission dispensed with the appearance of the petitioners therein. He further submitted that petitioner/accused No.1 in the present criminal petition is also entitled to the same relief.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, issue notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks a week's time to obtain instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

The presence of petitioner/accused No.1 in C.C.No.353 of 2021 on the file of Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Bhongir, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that he shall be represented through his counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioner/accused No.1 is required, he shall appear before the trial Court. In case of non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for his appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
