WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through its Advocate SRI D MADHAVA RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus directing the Respondents No. 3 to 8 to forbade from handing over the management of SREE SREE SREE Katta Maisamma Devalayam temple or properties of temple constructed on the lake bund of Shamirpet lake as illegal and contrary to law;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri D MADHAVA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents 6 to 8, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No. 6 to 8 not to act in contravention of law as regards the temple its management and to pass, pending disposal of WP No. 8720 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

Personal notice is permitted.

It is submitted by Mr. D.Madhava Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner that under the guise of survey proposed to be conducted in respect of lands of the petitioner temple, there is an attempt made by respondent authorities to hand over possession of land of the temple to unofficial respondents.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue submits that Endowment Department is a proper and necessary party to the *lis*.

There shall be interim *status quo* obtaining as on today to be maintained until further orders. The petitioner is directed to implead the Endowment Department and other concerned authorities as respondents in the writ petition. This order shall not preclude the authorities from conducting survey pursuant to notice bearing File No.G/415/2021 dated 30.12.2021.
