ORDER: (per the Hon'ble Sri Justice P.SAM KOSHY)

Heard **Ms.N.Lavanya**, learned counsel representing
Mr.V.Raja Shekar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner,
learned Government Pleader for Services-III appearing for
respondent Nos.1, 4 and 5 and **Mr. K.V.Raman**, learned
standing counsel for the respondent Nos.2 & 3.



2. The present Writ Petition has been filed seeking for an appropriate Writ of Mandamus directing respondent Nos.1, 4 and 5 to ensure that the entire retiral benefits payable to the petitioner be released at the earliest.

3. The petitioner herein is a retired employee who inspite of having retired more than six months back, till date he has not received a single penny towards his post retiral benefits. The contents of the petition would reflect that the tokens for the release of the amount were issued way back in November 2025, inspite of tokens been issued more than six months back, even today the petitioner has not receive a single penny and not one token amount has been encashed.

4. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is facing acute crisis in sustaining himself post retirement and also in deciding the post retirement settlement in addition to his family responsibilities.



5. The learned Government Pleader for Services-III would submit that given a reasonable period of time the entire amount shall be released to the petitioner. However, he is not in a position to specify a fixed period of time within which the said retirement emoluments can be released.

6. It is an undisputed fact that the petitioner being a retired employee who has retired from the service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.10.2025 is entitled for the retiral benefits. The Government having accepted the dues payable to petitioner and as per their practice and procedure issued token numbers for the release of amounts which are reflected in Paragraph No.11 of the writ petition and runs into more than two pages, we do not intend to keep the writ petition pending.

7. Accordingly, we dispose of the present writ petition directing the respondent No.1 to ensure that the entire amount that are reflected in paragraph No.11 of the present writ petition running into more than two pages be forthwith released within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of



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this order, failing which, the entire amount of dues payable for which tokens have already been issued shall carry interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of retirement till the actual payment is made.

8. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands allowed. There shall be no order as to cost.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stands closed.

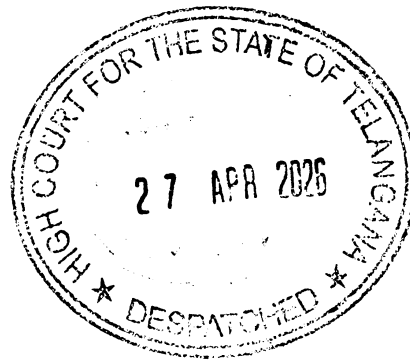
