**Heard Sri B.Balaji, learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the Petitioner.**

**2. The present Civil Revision Petition is filed
seeking prayer as under:**

"...to direct the learned Principal Junior Civil
Judge at Jangaon, to hear and dispose of the suit

in O.S.No.143 of 2022 at the earliest and pass such other order..."

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the limited relief as prayed for by the petitioner in the present Civil Revision Petition is a direction to the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge at Jangaon to hear and dispose of the suit O.S.No.143 of 2022 on merits, in accordance to law expeditiously.

4. **The petitioner/plaintiff filed the suit O.S.No.143 of 2022 seeking prayer as under:**

"...to pass a decree and judgment in favour of the plaintiff and against the defendants for permanent injunction restraining the defendants and their men, family members, workers, yesmen, attorney's servants etc., or any other person(s) claiming through them from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule property in any manner, II) to award the costs of the suit and III) to pass any other such relief..."

5. **Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner filed the suit**

O.S.No.143 of 2022 in the year 2022 and the same has been adjourned from time to time and the defendants in this suit have been dragging the suit proceedings on some pretext or the other and therefore appropriate orders may be passed for the expeditious disposal of the suit O.S.No.143 of 2022.

6. TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION:

a) The aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case,

b) The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner,

c) The material documents filed along with Memo dated 05.03.2026,

The Civil Revision Petition is disposed of, directing the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge at Jangaon to hear and dispose of finally the Suit O.S. No. 143 of 2022, on merits, in accordance to law,

preferably within a period of three (03) months, from the date of receipt of a copy of this Order. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Petition, shall stand closed.

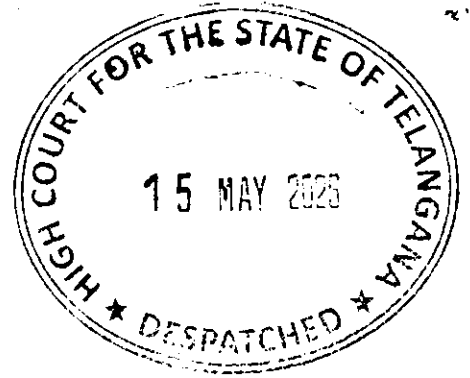
