Respondents

WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri Mummaneni Srinivasa Rao presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the arbitrary action of the respondent police in directing the petitioners not to proceed with the construction of their respective houses vide 1) H.No.13-52/6, 2) H.No.13-52/3, 3) H.No.13-52/2, 4) H.No.13-52/5 and 5) H.No.13-52/A, situated at Gumpennagudem Village, (Keshavapuram Panchayat), Charla Mandal, Bhadrachalam District, constructing the houses in Sy.No.33/AA/1, total to an extent of Ac.0-43 cents of patta land, purchased by the petitioners from the original landlord late Syamala Muthaiah, through independent sale deeds. Thereafter, the petitioners constructed houses in the said land and that the 10th respondent/Gram Panchayat has granted permission for construction of the houses to the petitioners and also allotted independent door numbers, and the petitioners are presently constructing the houses under Indiramma Scheme, at the instance of 5th respondent, who obtained injunction orders dated 22.09.2017 from Civil Court in I.A.No.185/2017 in O S.No.201/2017 on the file of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Mobile Court, Bhadrachalam, and also obtained police aid in I.A.No.542/2020 dated 23.11.2020, pending O.S.No.201/2017 and the suit was decreed on 19.08.2021, hence the injunction orders and police protection orders are not in force after the suit is decreed on 19.08.2021, but the 5th respondent claiming land in SY.No.33/A to an extent of Ac.5-40 cents of Agricultural land situated at Keshavapuram (G) Village, Charla Mandal, Bhadrachalam District, and also obtained Police protection orders from Hon'ble High Court orders passed in WP.No.23326 of 2022 dated 21.12.2022 to implement the Civil Injunction orders and police protection orders by suppressing the fact the said orders are not in force and the suit was decreed long back on 19.08.2021. The said orders obtained against the 3rd parties, the petitioners herein are not made as parties to the said proceedings i.e., either in the suit or in the writ petition, and the petitioners land situated in Sy.No.33/AA/1 and the 5th respondent land situated in Sy.no.33/A, which is an agricultural land to an extent of Ac.5-40 cents, and the petitioners land is a non-agricultural land to an extent of Ac.0-43 cents and the 5th respondent land is available agricultural land besides the petitioners land, is illegal, void and opposed to Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently to direct the Respondent police not to interfere with the Civil disputes between the petitioners and 5th respondent without following due process of law in respect of the lands in question.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Mummaneni Srinivasa Rao Advocate for the Petitioners and Sri M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home for respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.5,6 and 10 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
