Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction, failure and arbitrary conduct of the respondents in not implementing the order dated 01.12.2022 passed in W.P.No.5297 of 2019, and in not granting lawful and correct fixation of pay, including pay revisions/fixations for the years 2013, 2017 and 2021, counting of interregnum period of service, and addition of all eligible annual increments, and in not releasing deferred wages, interregnum wages, and salary arrears from the year 2014 till date, together with all attendant and consequential service and monetary benefits, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and contrary to the rules, regulations and circular

instructions governing the respondent-Corporation and consequently direct the respondents to re-fix and revise the petitioner's pay correctly by granting pay fixations for the years 2013, 2017 and 2021, with due counting of interregnum period of service and addition of all eligible annual increments.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to provisionally re-fix the petitioner's pay by granting pay fixations for the years 2013, 2017 and 2021, counting the interregnum period of service, and adding all eligible annual increments, and to release deferred wages, interregnum wages and arrears of salary from the year 2014 till date, along with all attendant and consequential service and monetary benefits, within a time-bound period, and/or direct the respondents to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 12.07.2024, by passing a reasoned order, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition.
