WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI RAPOLU BHASKAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.5 in interfering into the peaceful life and liberty and interfering into the matrimonial disputes between the Petitioner and Respondent No.6 and calling the Petitioner to the Police Station and detaining him and threatening to pay an amount of Rs.25.00 Lakhs to the Respondent No.6 by colluding with the Respondent No.6 to 8 is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violation of Articles 14, 15, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and also violation of Principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the Respondent No.5 not to interfere into the peaceful life and liberty and not to interfere into matrimonial disputes between the Petitioner and Respondent No.6 and not threaten to pay an amount of Rs.25.00 Lakhs towards maintenance and not to threaten the Petitioner to give Divorce to the Respondent No.6.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI RAPOLU BHASKAR Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME appearing for respondents No. 1 to 5 directed issue of notice to the Respondents No. 6 to 8 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 31.03.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.5 not to interfere into the peaceful life and liberty and not to interfere into matrimonial disputes between the Petitioner and Respondent No.6 and not threaten to pay an amount of Rs.25.00 Lakhs towards maintenance and not to threaten the Petitioner to give Divorce to the Respondent No.6, pending disposal of WP No.6529 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and waives further notice and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the official respondents are interfering into the *inter se* private matrimonial disputes pending between the petitioner and unofficial respondents by exerting pressure upon the petitioner to settle the dispute between them. This requires detailed examination.

The facts of the case can only be ascertained only upon filing of counter/instructions by official respondents.

In the mean time as in interim measure, respondent No.5 is directed not to interfere into the *inter se* private matrimonial disputes pending between the petitioner and unofficial respondents except under due process of law.
