Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or ion more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action the Respondent Nos.5 and 6 in non-considering the Representation of the dated 30.11.2025 and non-initiating to restore the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes on the land of the Petitioner to an extent of 0.24 Gts, in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and land to an extent of Ac.0.1333 in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.00.3733 Gts, which is situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District and trying to disposes the Petitioner from his land without issuing any notice and without following the due

process of law and consequently direct the Respondent Nos.5 and 6 to consider the representation of the Petitioner dated 30.11.2025 and restore the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes on the cultivating land of the Petitioner an extent of Ac.0.24 Gts, in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and land to an extent of Ac.0.1333 in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.00.3733 Gts, which is situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos.5 & 6 not to interfere into the peaceful possession and agriculture operations on the land of the Petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.24 Gts, in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and land to an extent of Ac.0.1333 in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.00.3733 Gts, which is situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District without issuing any notice and without following the due process of law pending disposal of the Writ Petition.

ORDER

**Heard Sri Rapolu Bhaskar, learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioner, learned
Assistant Government Pleader for Agriculture
appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and
5 and the learned Government Pleader for Revenue
appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.3 and 6.**

**2. The petitioner approached the Court seeking
prayer as under:**

"...to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent Nos.5 and 6 in non-considering the Representation of the Petitioner dated 30.11.2025 and non-initiating to restore the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes on the land of the Petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.24 Gts, in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and land to an extent of Ac.0.1333 in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.00.3733 Gts, which is situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District and trying to dispossess the Petitioner from his land without issuing any notice and without following the due process of law and consequently direct the Respondent Nos.5 and 6 to consider the representation of the Petitioner dated 30.11.2025 and restore the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes on the cultivating land of the Petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.24 Gts, in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and land to an extent of Ac.0.1333 in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.00.3733 Gts, which is situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case...."

3. The case of the petitioner in brief as per the averments made in the affidavit filed by the petitioner in support of the present Writ Petition is as under:-

- i) The petitioner is the owner and possessor of agricultural land to an extent of Ac.0.24 guntas in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and Ac.0.1333 guntas in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling Ac.0.3733 guntas, situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Mandal, Jangaon District

having inherited the same from his ancestors and the petitioner has been cultivating the said land without any interruption.

ii) While so, Respondent Nos.5 and 6 interfered with the petitioner's peaceful possession and illegally cancelled the benefits of Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes in respect of the petitioner's land without issuing any notice and without following due process of law.

iii) The petitioner submitted a representation dated 30.11.2025 requesting the authorities to restore the said benefits, but the respondents failed to consider the same. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner approached this Court by filing the present writ petition.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION:

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner mainly puts forth the following submissions:

4.1 The petitioner made a detailed representation dated 30.11.2025 to Respondent Nos.5 and 6 requesting them to

restore the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes in respect of the petitioner's land.

4.2 Though the said representation was addressed to Respondent Nos.5 and 6, they have not initiated any steps to restore the petitioner's Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes.

4.3 The respondents cannot cancel the schemes to which the petitioner is entitled under law without issuing any prior notice and without following due process of law.

4.4 The respondent authorities cannot unilaterally cancel the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes, which the petitioner and his ancestors have been availing for a long period, without issuing any notice, as the same is in clear violation of the principles of natural justice.

Basing on the aforesaid submissions, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is entitled to the relief as prayed for in the present writ petition. Hence, appropriate directions may be issued to Respondent

Nos.5 and 6 to consider the grievance of the petitioner as put forth in the petitioner's representation dated 30.11.2025, in accordance to law, within a reasonable period.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Agriculture appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5 does not dispute the said submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

6. TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION:

a) The aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case,

b) The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Agriculture appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5,

c) The discussion and conclusion as arrived at paragraph Nos.4 and 5 of the present order,

The writ petition is disposed of, directing Respondent Nos.5 and 6 to consider the grievance of the petitioner as put forth in the petitioner's representation dated 30.11.2025 addressed to Respondent Nos.5 and 6, seeking restoration of the Rythu Bharosa (Rythu Bandhu) and Rythu Bheema Schemes in respect of the petitioner's land to an extent of Ac.0.24 guntas in Survey No.802/A/2/1/2 and Ac.0.1333 guntas in Survey No.802/B/1/3/1/2, totaling to an extent of Ac.0.3733 guntas, situated at Kundaram Village, Lingala Ghanpur Manda, Jangaon District, and to pass appropriate orders in accordance to law within a period of three (3) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, and duly communicate the decision on the said representation to the petitioner herein. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.

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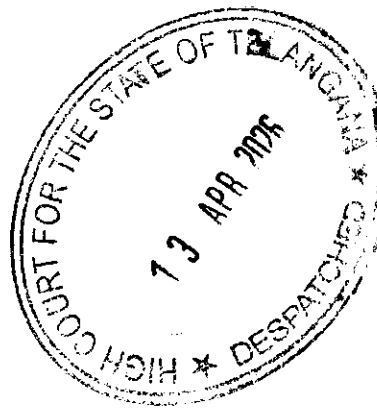
