WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI S K SHABBER AHMED presented this Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the Impugned Chargesheet bearing the number CC No. 845/2024 pending on the file of the I Junior Civil Judge cum Judicial Magistrate First Class at Achampeta against the Petitioner.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. VEDULA SRINIVAS, Senior Counsel representing SRI S K SHABBER AHMED Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 20.04.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including coercive steps and appearance of the Petitioner i.e., the Sole Accused in C.C. No. 845 of 2024 pending on the file of the I Junior Civil Judge cum Judicial Magistrate First Class at Achampet, pending disposal of the above Criminal Petition.

ORDER:**

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to furnish one set of material papers to the learned Government Pleader for Irrigation and file proof of service.

Mr.Vedula Srinivas, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr.S.K.Shabber Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's company Achampet Solar Private Limited had purchased the property through three (3) registered sale deeds on 08.06.2016 by paying valuable sale consideration and since then, the said company was in possession of the said property and made application before the revenue officials for conversion of agricultural land into non-agricultural purpose. Pursuant to the said application, the Revenue Divisional Officer, Achampet Division, vide proceedings No.E/15/2016, dated 07.12.2016 granted nala conversion proceedings in favour of the petitioner's company after duly taking into consideration the report submitted by the Tahsildar, Achampet, dated 02.11.2016. He further submitted that respondent

No.2 filed the present complaint alleging that the said property belongs to Irrigation Department and the same is contrary to the proceedings issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer, dated 07.12.2016. Hence, continuation of proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 20.04.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused in C.C.No.845 of 2024 on the file of the I Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Achampet.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
