No. 73 Of 2025, before the III Additional Junior Civil Judge -Cum – III Additional Judicial Magistrate Of First Class Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kushaiguda, pending disposal of the case.

The Court made the following:
ORDER:

Mr. A. Sharat Chandra, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.2 filed D.V.C.No.73 of 2025 seeking various reliefs though the provisions of the act are not attracted against the petitioners on the ground that there is no domestic relationship between the petitioners and respondent No.2. He further submits that the petitioner in Crl.P.No.3217 of 2026 filed F.C.O.P.No.200 of 2021 on the file of the Family Court-cum-II Additional District Judge, at Hanamkonda seeking dissolution of the marriage of the petitioner and respondent No.2 by invoking provisions under Section 12(1)(ia)(iii) of the Hindu Marriage Act, which was allowed on 07.10.2022 and the marriage between the petitioner and respondent No.2 was dissolved. After waiting for a period of one year, the petitioner performed another marriage on 18.11.2023 and blessed with a baby girl on 04.09.2024. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Post on 20.04.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/respondent Nos.1 to 6 in D.V.C.No.73 of 2026 on the file of the III Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-III Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kushaiguda.

In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.
