Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS to declare the oral proposal and attempts by the respondents to remove/demolish the statues of K. Narasimha Reddy, R. Gali Reddy and K. Paramesh at Chowdarpally Village without following the due process of law as illegal, arbitrary and violation of Telangana State Panchayat Raj Act, 2018, Article 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently, this Hon'ble Court may direct the respondents to forbear from demolishing or interfering with the said statues without strictly adhering to the procedure established by law.
