WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri Rapolu Bhaskar presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.6 non-considering the representation dated 10/04/2025 of the petitioner and non-initiating to take the

necessary action against the illegal construction of the respondent No.8 to 11 by occupying the part of the plot of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.52 cents (Ac.0.20 gts) in Sy.No.499 which is situated at Velaturu Village and Gram Panchayat, Chinambavi Mandal, Wanaparthy District, and constructing the compound wall and Venu Gopala Swamy Temple, without having any right and title, is highly illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violation of Principles of Natural Justice and also in violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, apart from violation of Telangana Panchayat Raj Act and consequently direct the respondent No.6 to consider the representation dated 10.04.2025 of the petitioner and to take the necessary action against the illegal construction of the respondent No.8 to 11 by occupying the part of the plot of the petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.52 cents (Ac.0.20 gts) in Sy.No.499 which is situated at Velaturu Village and Gram Panchayat, Chinambavi Mandal, Wanaparthy District, and constructing the compound wall and Venu Gopala Swamy Temple, without having any right and title, the above plot belongs to the petitioner.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Rapolu Bhaskar Advocate for the Petitioner, Mr. P. Ashok Kumar, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj, for the respondent Nos.1 to 5 and Sri K. Pradeep Reddy, learned Standing Counsel, for 6th respondent, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 7 to 11 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
