WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI S M SAIFULLAH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the action of the 2nd and 3rd Respondents in not returning the original academic qualification certificates of the petitioner who has discontinued study of B-Pharmacy Course in the 1st year in the 3rd respondent's College as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Articles 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd and 3rd respondents to return the petitioners original certificates viz (1) Original SSC Examination Certificate, (2) Original Memorandum of marks in Intermediate, (3) Original Transfer Certificate, (4) Original Bonafied of SSC and Intermediate, to the petitioner.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI S M SAIFULLAH Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
