WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P PANDU RANGA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, Order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the official respondents in interfering with the Civil disputes pending between the petitioner and the respondent No.4 and threatening and harassing the petitioner to settle the lis with the 4th respondent as being arbitrary, illegal and unconstitutional and violative of Petitioner's constitutional and fundamental rights guaranteed under Constitution of India and consequently direct the official respondents not to interfere in civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.4 and not to subject the petitioner and his family members to any harassment or implicating false cases.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P PANDU RANGA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri M. Srinivas, Assistant Government Pleader

for Home, for the respondent Nos.1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

Dr. Ravi, Occ. Govt Employee, R/o H.No.2-3-117, Opposite Shishu Mandir, Munugodu Road Sakalalla Bazar, Pottugadda, Nalgonda Town and Nalgonda District.

are directed to show cause on or before 22.04.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to threaten or harass the petitioner and his family members in any manner and not to call upon to their offices, pending disposal of WP No. 7481 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Notice before admission.

Sri M. Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for the respondent Nos.1 to 3, seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to the 4th respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the 4th respondent by Speed Post with acknowledgment due (SPAD) and file proof of service.

Since it has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that at the behest of the 4th respondent, the 3rd respondent has been exerting pressure upon the petitioner to settle the matter with the unofficial respondent by interfering into the civil disputes between the petitioner the unofficial respondent, the fact can be ascertained upon filing the counter and instructions by the official respondents. Meanwhile, as in interim measure, 3rd respondent is directed not to interfere between the *inter se* disputes between the petitioner and the unofficial respondent. Except in accordance with law.
