COMMON ORDER:

Since the issue involved in both the transfer petitions is one and the same and the parties also same, they are being heard together and disposed of by way of this common order.

Tr.C.M.P.No.142 of 2026 is filed by the petitioner-husband seeking to transfer H.M.O.P.No.68 of 2025 from the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Ramannapeta of Yadadri-Bhongir District, to the Family Court at Hanumakonda.

Tr.C.M.P.No.112 of 2026 filed by the wife seeking transfer of F.C.O.P.No.194 of 2024 pending on the file of the Family Court, Hanumakonda, to the file of the Senior Civil Judge at Ramannapet, Yadadri-Bhongir District, to be heard along with H.M.O.P.No.68 of 2025.

During arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the respondent have reached consensus that both the matters be transferred to Bhongir as one of the criminal case is pending on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Bhongir.

In view of the same, both the Tr.CMPs are allowed by transferring H.M.O.P.No.68 of 2025 and F.C.O.P.No.194 of 2024 to the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Bhongir. No costs.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this petition, shall stand closed.

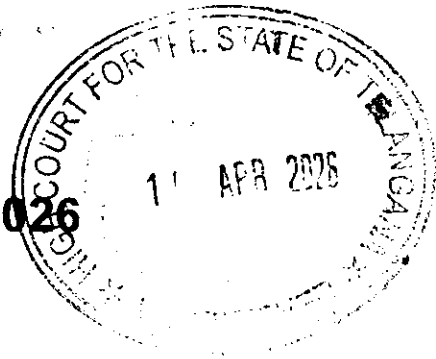
