Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents in not conducting survey and demarcation of the land admeasuring 978 square yards situated in Survey Nos. 74 & 75 correlated to T.S.Nos.17/1 & 17/2, Block-A, Ward-244, Nandimuslaiguda Village, Bahadurpura Mandal, Hyderabad District, despite issuance of notices dated 06-05-2025 and 17-06-2025 and despite there being no subsisting restraint order, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Articles 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents to conduct and complete survey and demarcation of the above said land in accordance with law, within a time-bound

period, and to submit a demarcation/compliance report, and Quash the endorsement dated 07-04-2021 issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Hyderabad Division and Quash the MeeSeva rejection orders rejecting the petitioner's applications for demarcation and also Direct that demarcation be carried out with police protection, if any obstruction is caused by private respondents;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to fix a date and conduct survey and demarcation of the land admeasuring 978 sq. yards in Sy. Nos. 74 & 75 correlated to T.S. Nos. 17/1 and 17/2, Nandimustlaiguda Village, Bahadurpura Mandal, Hyderabad, in terms of the notices dated 06-05-2025 and 17-06-2025, and to submit a compliance / demarcation report before this Court, pending disposal of WP 8776 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Gurmeet Singh, Party-in-Person for the Petitioner, GP FOR Revenue, for the Respondent Nos.1 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard petitioner-Party-in-Person and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

There shall be interim direction to the respondent No.5 to conduct survey of the land admeasuring 978 sq. yards, Sy.Nos.74 and 75, correlated to T.S.Nos.17/1 and 17/2, Block-A, Ward-244, Nandimustlaiguda Village, Bahadurpura Mandal, Hyderabad District, pursuant to notices in File No.B/547/2025 dated 06.05.2025 and 17.06.2025, by affording opportunity to the petitioner and respondents No.6 to 12, within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order
