Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.3, in repeatedly calling the petitioner to the police station and interfering in a purely civil dispute which is already pending in O.S. No.739 of 2021 without having jurisdiction, as illegal, improper, arbitrary, unconstitutional and against the principles of natural justice, consequently direct the respondent No.3 not to interfere in the civil dispute, not to harass the petitioner.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.3 not to interfere in the civil dispute, not to harass the petitioner, pending disposal of WP 7600 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI D. SATYANARAYANA Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents No.1 to 3, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives further notice and seeks time to get instructions or to file counter.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that admittedly there are civil disputes in O.S.No739 of 2021 on the file of VIII Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, at Hyderabad pending between the other private individuals and the petitioner where the petitioner is the defendant and respondent No.3 is interfering into the personal liberty of the petitioner herein without following due process of law.

These facts can only be ascertained upon filing of the counter/instructions by the official respondents.

In the meanwhile, respondent No.3 is directed not to interfere into the personal life and liberty of the petitioner without following due process of law.
