WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI VADLAKONDA RAVI KUMAR REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 4th respondent in proposing to receive, register and release the alienation deed such as sale deed/mortgage/gift deed etc., presented by the 5th respondent pertaining to the agricultural land admeasuring Ac.0.22 guntas of Sy.No.563 situated at Medipalli village, Ramagundam Mandal, Peddapalli District even without considering the objections and also the factual matrix obtaining in the case as illegal, arbitrary, violative of principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the constitution of India and direct the 4th respondent not to entertain any alienations such as sale deed/mortgage/gift deed etc., presented by the 5th respondent pertaining to the agricultural land admeasuring Ac.0.22 guntas of Sy.No.563 situated at Medipalli village, Ramagundam Mandal, Peddapalli District.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VADLAKONDA RAVI KUMAR REDDY

Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

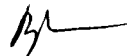
Registry is directed not to take out further notice to respondent Nos.1 to 4, in view of the above waiver.
