Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.7 in instructing the Respondent No.3 authorities, namely the Respondent Nos.8 and 9 to illegally demolish the Petitioner's property, under the

guise of unauthorised construction and trying to illegal dispossess the Petitioner from her premises bearing H.No. 16-1-47/2, situated in Shivajinagar, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District to facilitate the construction of a shopping complex proposed to be constructed by the Respondent No.5 Company and to widen the road as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violation of the provisions of Telanagana Municipalities Act besides violation of Articles 21, 19(10) (e) and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2, a) To consider the representation dt.25/02/2026 of the Petitioner and conduct inquiry and take appropriate action against the Respondent Nos.7 to 9 for illegally demolishing the Petitioner's building bearing H.No. 16-1-47/2, situated in Shivajinagar, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District. b) To determine and pay compensation to the Petitioner and recover the amount from Respondent Nos.7 to 9 as per the directions passed by the Honourable Supreme Court in the case of Re: Directions in the matter of demolition of Structures. c) Not to interfere in the peaceful possession and dispossess of the Petitioner from her premises bearing H.No. 16-1-47/2, situated in Shivajinagar, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District without following the due process of law. d) To stop the unauthorized construction of shopping complex constructed in Ramagundam area and pass such other order or orders as the Honourable Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to interfere in the peaceful possession of the Petitioner premises bearing H.No. 16-1-47/2, situated in Shivajinagar, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District, pending disposal of the above Writ Petition, pending disposal of WP No. 7977 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

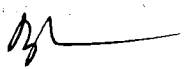
