ORDER:

This Criminal Petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.69 of 2023, on the file of the I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar.

Mr. E. Sreenivas Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. M. Rajashekhar Reddy, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3, submit that during the pendency of this criminal petition, at the instance of elders and well wishers, respondent Nos.2 and 3, and the petitioners were entered into compromise and filed I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2026 seeking permission
