WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/s MEREDDY TEJASWINI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declaring the action of the respondent Nos.5 and 6 and their authorities calling the petitioners designated partners to the 6th respondent police station and insisting and directing the petitioners to settle the matter with the unofficial respondent No.7 under his

influence in respect of an extent of Ac.09-20 gts in Sy. No.176/AA/1/1/1/2, situated at Ghatpally Village, Maheswaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District inspite of various civil cases pending various courts as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and is nothing but misuse and abuse of their official powers and also pecuniary advantage by abusing their position and power as a public servant which is violation of Article 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the constitution of India by consequently directing the respondents 5 and 6 and their authorities to call the petitioner firm's designated partners under the influence of the unofficial 7th Respondent and not to call to the respondent No.6's police station by directing the respondent Nos.5 and 6 to not to interfere in the civil disputes pending in between the petitioner and the respondent No.7 in respect of an extent of Ac.09-20 gts in Sy. No.176/AA/1/1/1/2, situated at Ghatpally Village, Maheswaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s MEREDDY TEJASWINI, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned Government Pleader for Home shall get instructions by the next date of hearing.

Respondent No.6 - Station House Officer, Maheshwaram Police Station, Rachakonda Police Commissionerate, shall not interfere in civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.7 in connection

with the subject land admeasuring Acs.9-20 guntas in Survey No.176/AA/1/1/2, situated at Ghatpally Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District. However, this order shall not have any bearing on the disputes regarding title and possession between the petitioner and respondent No.7 and other private parties.

Issue notice to respondent No.7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.7 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.
