AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI AKKAM ESHWAR Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners are permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Mr.Akkam Eshwar, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in this criminal petition is squarely covered by the orders passed by the erstwhile Combined High Court of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh in Crl.P. No.13440 of 2010, dated 03.11.2017, wherein accused No.1 approached this Court for seeking quashment of the proceedings in P.R.C. No.96 of 2010, and this Court accordingly quashed the proceedings against accused No.1. Hence, the present petitioners are also entitled to very same benefit, as the allegations levelled against them are identical in nature. He further submitted that accused No.8 had also approached this Court by filing Crl.P.No.2386 of 2021, and this Court, by order dated 29.11.2021, allowed the said criminal petition and quashed the proceedings against the said accused.
