Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos.8 and 9 not to install the idol (Bodrai) in front of petitioner premises bearing house No.19-7-55 consisting of open land in Sy.No.190 situated at Rangasaipet, Warangal, pending disposal of the above Writ Petition No.9358 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following (The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case)

ORDER:

As the installation of religious idols, Bodrai / Stone of any idols, etcetera is governed by the specific rules framed by the Government, Respondents 2 and 3 shall not grant any permission without strictly adhering to the procedure prescribed therefor.

Learned Standing Counsel for the Corporation apprehends that installation of Bodrai / stone may be carried out during late night. Hence, Respondents 3 to 7 shall ensure that no such installation of Bodrai / stone is made without obtaining permission from the respondents and in the event any such activity is being proposed, the official respondents shall interfere with the same and prevent such installation. Respondents 8 and 9 are also enjoined from installing the idol (Bodrai) in front of the petitioner's premises.
