WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Dr CHALLA SRINIVASA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, By declaring the action of Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 in proceeding to conduct the Bar Association, Ibrahimpatnam elections scheduled to be held on 30/03/2026, in violation of the directions issued by Respondent No.1 vide proceedings dated 14/03/2026, and by excluding the petitioners and other members from the voter list, as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to the Bar Council Rules and By-laws, and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently 1) To direct Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to conduct the elections to the Bar Association of Ibrahimpatnam strictly in accordance with the directions issued by Respondent No.1 and the voter list approved/furnished by Respondent No.1 by rescheduling the election process, 2) To direct Respondent No.1 to take appropriate action, in

accordance with law and applicable rules, against Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for acting in violation of the directions dated 14/03/2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Dr CHALLA SRINIVASA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
