WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI GUMMALLA BHASKER REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order, or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of Mandamus. i) To declare the action of the Respondents in issuing Look Out Circular (LOC) against Petitioner under the guise of being arrayed as Accused No.11 in FIR No. RC0782025E0004 registered by BS and FB Bangalore under sections 420, 409, 468, 471, 477-A r/w 120-B of IPC and sections 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as illegal, arbitrary and violative of articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequentially set aside the same. ii) To direct the Respondents No.2 and 3 not to interfere with the Travel of the Petitioner from India under the guise of being arrayed as Accused No.11 in FIR No. RC0782025E0004 registered by BS and FB Banglore.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI GUMMALLA BHASKER REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri S.Sunil, learned Senior Standing Counsel for Central Government representing Sri N.Bhujanga Rao, learned Deputy Solicitor General of

India, for respondent Nos.1 to 3, Sri Srinivas Kapatia, learned Special Public Prosecutor for CBI, for respondent No.4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
