RANGANATHAN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the Minutes of Meeting dated 10.07.2023 issued by the third respondent through Letter No. TAFRC/03/ Medical/Dental/PG/Fee/2023 dated 14.07.2023 and the consequential G.O.Ms.No.107 dated 28.07.2023 and G.O.Ms.No.131 dated 18.08.2023 issued by the first respondent as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violative of fundamental rights, and consequently set aside the same.
